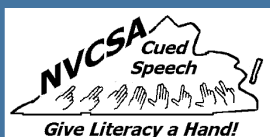


Need Phonics? ...CUE!

CCVA has Something for Everyone!

- **Families with children who are deaf-or hard-of-hearing:** If your deaf or hard-of-hearing child is age 5 or younger, use the *Jump-Start Cued Language program* to bring your whole family to Cue Camp for **\$175!** Pro-rated family fees and financial assistance are also available.
- **Cued Language Transliterators:** Attend the CLT Training program to gain transliterating experience and receive feedback from nationally certified mentors. Language Matters Academy - will present a cue-reading class for current and aspiring CLTs on Sunday morning. *TECUnit CEH's* are available for nationally certified CLTs for up to 2.5 days. Email us for more info.
- **Professionals:** Teachers of the Deaf, Speech/Language Pathologists, Audiologists, students or other professionals in fields related to deafness can learn to cue! Apply for the Adam Schuler Memorial Scholarship (*covering 100% of camp fees*) for Professionals. (Ask about VA training grants and VSDB Outreach scholarships.)
- **Deaf Adult Cuers:** Reconnect with long-time friends from the "cuemunity"! Give back to the next generation of cuers by volunteering to work with children's groups and mentor young cuers. Share your experiences with new families!
